- Routine and stat services provided at our three locations: TidalHealth Peninsula Regional campus, McCready FMF, and Ocean Pines Cancer Center Lab.
- Specimen collection and courier services to the TidalHealth campuses.
- Comprehensive test menu appropriate and responsive to the needs of the population served by our facilities.
- A testing catalog, accessible on-line, defining our on-site and reference facility tests and detailing specimen requirements, specific normal ranges, location of testing, days performed, and more.
- Research specimen processing/packaging to support Cancer Center clinical trials
- Accurate and timely results to support optimal patient care and community wellness, including critical action values notification.
- Medical staff approved reference laboratory services.
- Consultation services for test utilization and interpretation of results
- Education for our laboratory students, hospital staff and physicians to promote quality and appropriate use of our services.
